## 5 LOAVES 2 FISHES

# "And he said unto them, How is it that ye do not understand?" 

[Mark 8:21]
"And they say unto him, We have here but five loaves, and two fishes" [Matt 14:17].
"And they did all eat, and were filled: and they took up of the fragments that remained twelve baskets full." [Matt 14:20]
"And he asked them, How many loaves have ye? And they said, Seven." [Mark 8:5]
"And when the seven among four thousand, how many baskets full of fragments took ye up? And they said, Seven." [Mark 8:20]
"And He [Jesus] said unto them [Apostles], How is it that ye do not understand?"
[Mark 8:21].

So let us understand, for we all know, that The Scriptures, are Parables of the Spiritual Things. These Scriptures [St Mark 8:17-21], that are telling of these two events, of the feeding of the 5000 and of the 4000, are filled with so many Incredibly Spiritual Truths, that it is Miraculously Amazing and understandable that the Apostles, at that time, didn't understand, what Jesus was referring to. Where do I start, well, I guess with the 5 loaves and 2 fishes, which is the "Bread of Life" and the "Meat of the Word". And the Apostles said, "we have here", which means they had received the Word. And the passage, "And they did eat, and were filled", is that the Word was giving to the people and they also, received it. And the 5 loaves and the 2 fishes added together are the parable of the 7 spiritual gifts, giving to each of us, "dividing to every man severally as he will" [1 Cor 12:11], the several being the 5 loaves, "but covet earnestly the best gifts" [1 Cor 12:31], which are the 2 fishes. For as the Lord, which had received the Seven

Spirits from God, [Rev 3:1], we also, which were made after, "the Image of God" [Gen 1:27], have also received the Seven Spirits, but not in the Full Measure as Christ the Word, had received them. "For He whom God hath sent speaketh the Words of God: for God giveth not the Spirit by Measure unto Him" [John 3:34]. But unto man, we received the spiritual gifts, by measure. "But unto every one of us is given grace according to the measure of the gift of Christ" [Eph 4:7]. So now let us understand, the rest of these Amazing Scriptures. The passage that says, "fragments that remained twelve baskets full" [Matt 14:20], is the reference to the Remnant, all 12 tribes, that pass through the end times unhurt, by the Seal of God, the Passover mark. The next scripture, "how many baskets full of fragments, took ye up? They say unto Him, Twelve" [Mark 8:19]. This is the Remnant, taking to Heaven, "redeemed from among men, being the firstfruits unto God and to the Lamb" [Rev 14:4]. And now about the Seven, "how many baskets full of fragments, took ye up? And they said, Seven" [Mark 8:20]. This is in reference to the multitudes of peoples from the Seven Churches, that will be taken up on the last day of the millennium, both those who are alive and those righteous, from the graves . For as we all are from Adam, so are all of the Churches of today from the Seven Churches, "the Seven Candlesticks before the Throne of God" [Rev 1:20]. For as God set in the churches member divers of gifts and works, God also saw it fit and needful to have diversity of Churches with the diversity, of gifts and works, the "Seven Churches". So the Bride of Christ are, the 144000, the Remnant, and the Seven Churches, the 12 and the 7. "MIRACULOUSLY AMAZING" No man could write such a thing.
