SEVEN KINGS

And there are seven kings: five are fallen, and one is, and the other is not yet come; and when the cometh, he must continue a short space.

And the beast that was, and is not, even he is the eighth, and is of the seven, and goeth into perdition.

REVALATIONS 17:9-10

So let us understand these two verses, these kings, are the seven evil spirits of lucifer. The five kings that are fallen, are the five spiritual kings of lucifer's spirit, which were manifested in Heaven and convince one third of the angels of Heaven to believe his words. Proverbs 6: 16-19, describes them well, but this Proverb was addressing the things of man, that God Hates. But they corilate to what satan did in Heaven, he became vain and proud, the first king, and he devised wickedness against God, the second king, he soweth discord among the angels, the third king, he became the father of the lie, the fourth king, and he warred in Heaven, trying to overtake the righteous ones, the fifth king. And then satan was defeated in Heaven and cast out, and fell. These are the five kings that are fallen.

And so the devil found himself on the earth among men, and he devised his plan to hurt God, by making as many men as he could, turn from God. This plan is the sixth king, "and one is", which "was and is" here now among us, an evil manifestation of the devils spirit, tempting us daily. And you know the name of this sixth king, for it is the root of all evil here on the earth . The name of the sixth king is, <u>the love of money</u>, "for the love of money is the root of all evil: " [1 Tim 6:10]. And the seventh king, which has not yet come, which will continue a short space, and that short space is 3½ years, the time frame of the reign of the antichrist. And the name of this seventh evil spiritual king, is <u>blaspheme</u>, the antichrist. And these seven evil spiritual kings, are of the eighth, that goeth into perdition, lucifer, satan, the dragon, the devil. AMEN
