## IN THE BEGINNING

God was alone, in the beginning, but He has made known to us, the mystery of His Will,+ according to His Good Pleasure, which He Purposed within Himself. [Eph 1:9]. His thoughts were to make % Way+, that he could share % dis Love+. So, when He had concluded % he Way+, from the beginning to the end, the Alpha and Omega [Rev 22:13]. He called these thoughts, % The Word+ And % Word+was with God and the % Word+was God [John 1:1]. The same was in the beginning with God [John 1:2]. And God spoke The Word+forth [Eze 12:28], and it went out into the darkness, to fulfill the Work of the Creation of God. And Wine Word+, became Whe Light+, And the light, shineth in darkness; and the darkness comprehend it not+ [John 1:5]. And by Wis Light, Wine Word+from God, made all things, that were made [John 1:3]. So let us understand the mystery of this. In Ephesians it says, % And to make all men see what is the fellowship of the mystery, which from the beginning of the world hath been hid in God, who created all things by Jesus Christ:+[Eph 3:9]. And then, Mand the Word was made flesh, and dwelt among us, Full of Grace and Truth+[John 1:14]. So we know that The Word+is Jesus the Christ, who walked among us. And that The Word+was The Way+[John14:6] and that whe Word+became whe Light, what was the True Light, which lighteth every man that cometh into the world+[John 1:9]. So we know then that, 5 whe Word+, in the beginning was Jesus Christ, who did the Work of Creation. Who is the image of the invisible God, the firstborn of every creature+[Col 1:15]. So then The Word,+that God sent out, was this Manage of God+, Whe First Born of Every Creature+, Whis Son+, Separate Creature from God+, Born from The Will of God+. So from the time % he Word+, was sent out, until % he Word+became flesh, where and what was % tet-? Well as God is Spirit, so was % the Word+, during this time. % tet-was His Son, who was the Image of the Invisible God, which was Born into Existence, into the Spirit Realm, when God spoke His Son forth, and that when God, became Father God, Amen. And what

image was this? This Image: % for it pleased the Father that in Him, should all fullness dwell: [Col 1:19]. And what, fullness is this? This Fullness; 56 or God giveth not the Spirit by Measure unto Him (Jesus)+[ John 3:34]. And what Spirit is This? This Spirit; % Ind there were seven lamps of fire burning before the throne, which are the Seven Spirits of God+[Rev 4:5], that the Father gave to His Son, whe Word+, and sent Him forth, to do whe Work of God, by The Word of God, that was, with God in the Beginning. And Jesus in Revelations says, whese things saith He, that hath the Seven Spirits of God, and the Seven Stars+[Rev 3:1], which are the % Angels of the Seven Churches [Rev 1:20]. And so when Jesus, The Word+, The Way+, The Life+and Whe Light+said, Whe that has seen me, hath seen the Father+[John 20:29], was speaking of these Seven Spirits, that God Created in His Likeness, and gave to His Son, at His Spiritual Birth, the Image of God. "The Word that was God and with God, before God spoke the Word forth, which became the Firstborn of every Creature, His Son, Jesus the Christ. 1John 5:7 says, ‰or there are three that bear record in heaven, the Father, the Word, and the Holy Ghost: and these three are one+. Let us understand this scripture. If I tell you something that you do not know, do I still know it after I have told you. The answer is YES. And after God the Father spoke the Word forth, His Son, the Christ, God still retained all of the Word. If fact more of the Word, for only God our Father knows the day and the hour of his coming. So there is God, the Word, which are the thoughts of God and the Holy Ghost, which are the Seven Spirits of God, and they are ONE and the same. But the Word, God spoke forth, is the firstborn of every creature+[Col 1:15] His Spiritual Son, a separate creature from God. Remember when Jesus was ready to depart, He said, I must go, so that I am able to send the Comforter, % be Spirit of Truth+, [John 15:26]. Which are the Seven Spirits of God sent forth into all the earth+ [Rev 5:6], Also Jesus, who was spoken forth from the Word, also has the Word, and was giving the gifts of the Seven Spirits of God, when He became the First Creature of Creation.

‰nd when all things shall be subdued unto Him, then shall the Son also Himself be subject unto Him that put all things under Him, that God may be All in All+[Cor 15:28]. Amen.
